Summary

Invincible Spirit, sire of this yearling, had his 1st crop of two year olds on the racecourses in 2006 and he quickly established himself as a quality sire becoming the European Champion First Crop Sire that year. His success did not stop there as in his first two crops he produced no less than twelve stakes winners including six Group winners. He has been so successful that his covering fee has now been raised from €10,000 to €50,000 with his progeny being very highly sought after.

The success continued and in July 2009 one of his progeny, Fleeting Spirit, put in a tremendous performance to win at the highest level, the Group 1 Darley July Cup at Newmarket, when taking on horses from around the World. This was her fourth group win and took her earnings to over £1/2m.

This colt's dam, by the respected broodmare sire Warning, has already produced four winners from five runners. These include Manston who was also purchased as a yearling by our bloodstock agents. Manston won three races including the Listed Doncaster Stakes and achieved an official rating of 106. The second dam is a full sister to a Group 2 winner and she produced six winning foals of which three won 'black type' races.

He is a very attractive and good sized colt and has absolutely everything going for him being by a proven quality sire out of a dam who has already shown she can produce the goods. A really exciting prospect from a dream stallion and it speaks volumes that the breeder of this colt, who knows him better than anyone, has insisted in taking a share in him with us.

Qualified for the £300,000 St Leger Yearling Stakes, a race previously won by his trainer Bryan Smart.
